

Update to the City of Gallup Growth Management Plan Gallup, New Mexico

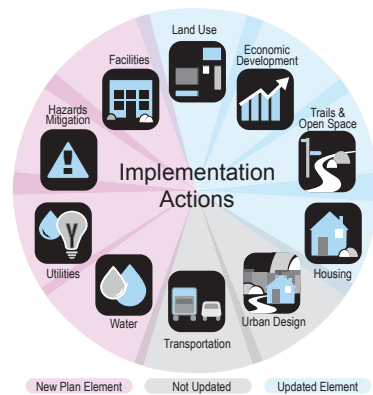
Architectural Research Consultants, Incorporated (ARC) completed an update of the City of Gallup's Growth Management Master Plan in February, 2016. Originally adopted by the City in 1999, the plan is a flexible document that ARC previously updated in 2009. The plan guides decisions about the physical development of the Gallup community. It helps the City prepare for the future by anticipating change, maximizing strengths, and anticipating weaknesses. It sets policies that help address critical issues facing the community, and recommends implementation actions needed to achieve those goals.

The growth management master plan encompasses all functional elements that bear on physical development in an internally consistent manner, including: land use, transportation, urban design, economic development, trails and open space, hazards mitigation, utilities, water, and housing.

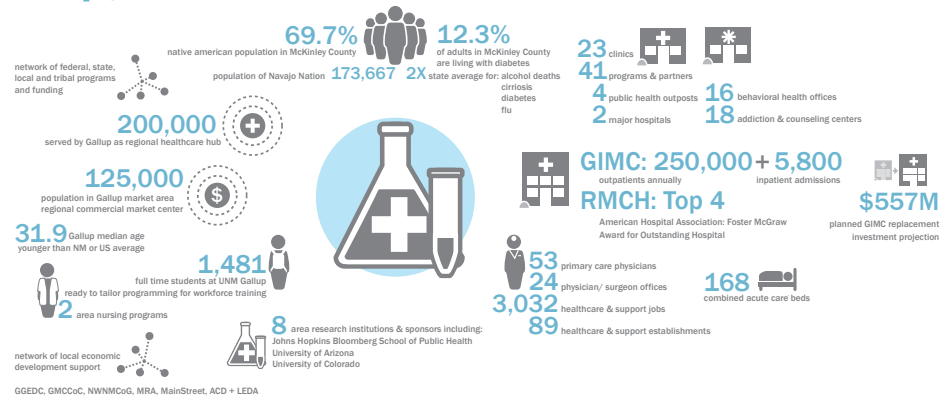
The 2016 update expanded the economic development component of the master plan with an appendix that included the topics of film production and cluster asset mapping. ARC collaborated with representatives from the City, Greater Gallup Economic Development Corporation, and other economic development leaders to develop an "asset map" for pursuing development in the medical treatment, research and light manufacturing sector.

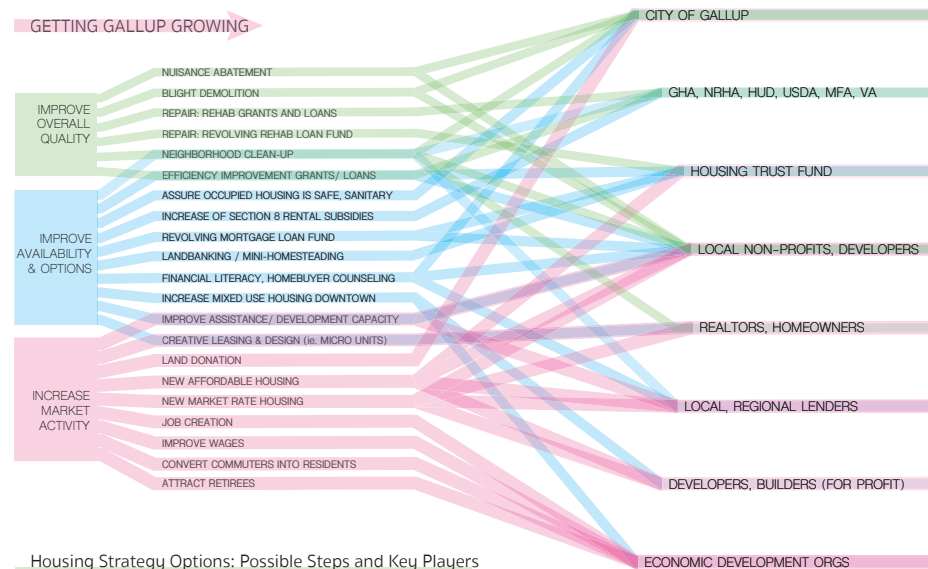
